Purpose

The purpose of the Phi Theta Kappa Membership Fund is to provide opportunities to students with financial hardships to accept membership into Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society. With active membership, Phi Theta Kappans evolve into campus leaders understanding the value in community service, while engaging in an intellectual climate for exchange of ideas and ideals, for lively fellowship for scholarship, and for stimulation of interest in continuing academic excellence.

Acceptable uses for the fund

This fund has been set up to assist with the membership fee associated with the Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society.

Eligibility

- Student must be currently enrolled in an academic program at NTC.
- Student must meet the requirement of Phi Theta Kappa (PTK) membership (successfully completed 12+ credits with a 3.5 or higher cumulative GPA).
- Student must have two more semesters to complete their program at NTC remaining after accepting PTK membership.
- Student has explored other sources for monetary assistance.

Preference

This is a competitive application to cover up to \$35 of the \$65 PTK membership fee. Preference is granted to students with plans to be actively involved with NTC's Beta Rho Zeta chapter during the current and forthcoming semesters. Applicants are strongly encouraged to attend an information session to learn more. Visit studentlife.ntc.edu/joinptk for upcoming sessions and information.
